Constituted 25 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Company D, 606th Engineer Camouflage Battalion

Activated 16 April 1943 at Camp Carson, Colorado

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1945 as Company D, 606th Army Engineer Camouflage Battalion

Inactivated 19 February 1946 at Camp Gruber, Oklahoma

Redesignated 10 January 1949 as Company D, 295th Engineer Camouflage Battalion and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 5 March 1949 at San Jose, California

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 13 August 1953 as Company D, 295th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 12 April 1954 as the 284th Engineer Company

Location changed 1 June 1954 to Palo Alto, California; on 1 June 1959 to Mountain View, California

Inactivated 29 February 1968 at Mountain View, California

Activated 16 September 2008 at Seagoville, Texas

Ordered into active military service 20 September 2013 at Seagoville, Texas; released from active military service 24 October 2014 and reverted to reserve status
