Redesignated 22 September 1947 as the 302d Engineer Treadway Bridge Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 October 1947 at Los Angeles, California

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1952 as the 302d Engineer Float Bridge Company

Reorganized and redesignated 10 July 1953 as the 302d Engineer Company

Inactivated 1 May 1959 at Los Angeles, California

Activated 1 March 1972 at Corpus Christi, Texas

Inactivated 15 April 2001 at Corpus Christi, Texas
