Constituted 9 March 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 1380th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company

Activated 15 March 1944 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Inactivated 23 December 1945 in India

Redesignated 2 October 1947 as the 304th Engineer Ponton Bridge Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 22 October 1947 at Pontiac, Michigan

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 24 June 1948 to Saginaw, Michigan

Inactivated 4 December 1950 at Saginaw, Michigan

Redesignated 16 April 1959 as the 304th Engineer Company

Activated 1 May 1959 at Saginaw, Michigan

Location changed 31 January 1962 to Battle Creek, Michigan

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at Battle Creek, Michigan

Activated 16 September 2008 at Lima, Ohio
