Constituted 23 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Company A, 796th Engineer Forestry Battalion

Activated 25 June 1943 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 24 February 1945 as the 1611th Engineer Forestry Company

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 2 October 1947 as the 305th Engineer Forestry Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 1 November 1947 at Seattle, Washington

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 17 November 1948 to Centralia, Washington

Inactivated 30 November 1950 at Centralia, Washington

Redesignated 24 September 2009 as the 305th Engineer Company

Activated 16 September 2012 at Camp Pendleton, California


