Redesignated 21 October 1947 as the 309th Engineer Maintenance Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 17 November 1947 at Holland, Michigan

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 17 November 1950 at Holland, Michigan

Redesignated 16 April 1959 as the 309th Engineer Company

Activated 1 May 1959 at Calumet, Michigan

Location changed 31 December 1965 to Battle Creek, Michigan

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Battle Creek, Michigan

Activated 16 September 1996 at Fargo, North Dakota
