Constituted 26 January 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 2824th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company

Activated 14 February 1945 in France

Inactivated 15 May 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 21 October 1947 as the 312th Engineer Panel Bridge Transport Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 17 November 1947 at Detroit, Michigan

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 24 June 1948 to Flint, Michigan

Reorganized and redesignated 2 February 1950 as the 312th Engineer Panel Bridge Company

Inactivated 9 April 1954 at Flint, Michigan

Redesignated 16 April 1959 as the 312th Engineer Company

Activated 1 May 1959 at Escanaba, Michigan

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Escanaba, Michigan; released from active military service 4 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Pontiac, Michigan


