Redesignated 13 January 1948 as the 315th Engineer Survey Liaison Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 22 January 1948 at Fort Myer, Virginia

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 1 January 1953 to Washington, D.C.

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1956 as the 315th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 15 May 1959 at Washington, D.C.

Activated 16 September 2008 at Butler, Pennsylvania
