(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 30 September 1953 as the 316th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 1 February 1956 at Buffalo, New York

Activated 16 June 1982 at Kittanning, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 15 June 2000 at Kittanning, Pennsylvania

Activated 16 September 2008 at Butler, Pennsylvania


