Activated 10 April 1953 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 31st Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 20 December 1954 in Korea

Activated 2 September 1958 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 15 August 1959 on Taiwan

Activated 25 March 1960 at the Nebraska Ordnance Plant, Wahoo, Nebraska


