Constituted 10 August 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 667th Engineer Topographic Company, Corps

Activated 20 September 1942 at Camp Maxey, Texas

Inactivated 28 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 19 November 1947 as the 320th Engineer Company, Corps, and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 15 December 1947 at Tacoma, Washington

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 September 1950 at Tacoma, Washington

Redesignated 21 January 1955 as the 320th Engineer Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 March 1955 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 25 October 1969 in Germany

Activated 16 June 1995 in Germany
