Inactivated 9 April 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 2 December 1947 as the 321st Engineer Forestry Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 10 December 1947 at Media, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 14 September 1950 at Media, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 2 April 2008 as the 321st Engineer Company

Activated 16 October 2010 at Conroe, Texas

Location changed 30 September 2012 to Houston, Texas

Ordered into active military service 1 November 2012 at Houston, Texas; released from active military service 5 December 2013 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 5 June 2022 at Houston, Texas; released from active military service 9 July 2023 and reverted to reserve status
