Constituted 31 December 1941 in the Army of the United States as the 427th Engineer Company, and activated at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1942 as the 427th Engineer Dump Truck Company

Disbanded 10 March 1945 in Italy

Reconstituted 24 December 1947 in the Organized Reserves as the 327th Engineer Panel Bridge Transport Company

Activated 14 January 1948 at Brooklyn, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 16 October 1948 to Jamaica, New York

Reorganized and redesignated 1 July 1950 as the 327th Engineer Panel Bridge Company

Location changed 21 October 1950 to Long Island City, New York; on 8 March 1951 to New York, New York

Reorganized and redesignated 17 January 1954 as the 327th Engineer Company

Location changed 2 January 1958 to Bronx, New York

Inactivated 1 May 1959 at Bronx, New York

Activated 16 September 2007 at Onalaska, Wisconsin


