Constituted 15 May 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 2729th Engineer Light Equipment Company

Activated 1 June 1944 at Camp Howze, Texas

Inactivated 10 April 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 24 December 1947 as the 328th Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 14 January 1948 at Hempstead, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 13 August 1948 to Jamaica, New York

Inactivated 31 July 1950 at Jamaica, New York

Redesignated 15 November 1955 as the 328th Engineer Company

Activated 1 December 1955 at Rochester, New York

Location changed 1 September 1960 to Penn Yan, New York; on 23 June 1966 to Fort Tilden, New York

Ordered into active military service 24 March 1970 at Fort Tilden, New York; released from active military service 26 March 1970 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Fort Tilden, New York

Ordered into active military service 20 March 2010 at Northfield, New Jersey; released from active military service 23 April 2011 and reverted to reserve status
