Constituted 1 September 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 1079th Engineer Dredge Crew

Activated 8 November 1943 at Fort Dupont, Delaware

Inactivated 15 November 1945 at Fort Dupont, Delaware

Redesignated 23 March 1948 as the 328th Engineer Dredge Crew and allotted to the Organized Reserves

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 7 April 1948 at New York, New York

Inactivated 9 November 1948 at New York, New York

Activated 1 December 1949 at Norfolk, Virginia

Ordered into active military service 21 September 1950 at Norfolk, Virginia; released from active military service 18 December 1952 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 22 April 1953 to Roanoke, Virginia

Reorganized and redesignated 5 May 1954 as the 328th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 4 June 1954 at Roanoke, Virginia

Activated 30 January 1968 at Alexandria, Virginia

Location changed 1 December 1975 to Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 31 May 1978 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia
