Constituted 13 August 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 787th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company

Activated 14 August 1943 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Inactivated 7 February 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 23 July 1947 as the 348th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 15 August 1947 at Alhambra, California

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 26 April 1949 to Maywood, California

Inactivated 28 November 1949 at Maywood, California

Activated 5 September 1950 at Fort Lee, Virginia

Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1952 as the 348th Engineer Pipeline Company

Reorganized and redesignated 26 April 1954 as the 348th Engineer Company

Location changed 20 March 1959 to Youngstown, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Youngstown, Ohio; released from active military service 12 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 30 August 1976 at Youngstown, Ohio

Activated 17 September 2001 at Cape Girardeau, Missouri

Inactivated 15 September 2006 at Cape Girardeau, Missouri

Activated 16 December 2011 at New Century, Kansas

Location changed 1 March 2013 to Kansas City, Missouri

Ordered into active military service 19 May 2019 at Kansas City, Missouri; released from active military service 17 May 2020 and reverted to reserve status
