Redesignated 16 July 1947 as the 350th Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 6 August 1947 at Minneapolis, Minnesota

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 18 December 1950 at Minneapolis, Minnesota

Redesignated 2 April 2008 as the 350th Engineer Company

Activated 16 October 2010 at Bell, California


