Constituted 29 November 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 1376th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company

Activated 15 December 1943 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Inactivated 16 April 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 11 July 1947 as the 352d Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 25 July 1947 at Dallas, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 8 March 1950 at Dallas, Texas

Redesignated 11 July 1956 as the 352d Engineer Company

Activated 1 August 1956 at Midland, Texas

Location changed 30 October 1956 to Littlefield, Texas

Inactivated 1 April 1959 at Littlefield, Texas

Activated 1 March 1963 at Tyler, Texas

Location changed 15 January 1968 to Yoakum, Texas


