Activated 14 February 1945 in France

Inactivated 19 November 1945 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Redesignated 27 June 1947 as the 357th Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 July 1947 at Tampa, Florida

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 1 June 1951 to Battleboro, North Carolina; on 1 January 1952 to Rocky Mount, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 5 April 1954 as the 357th Engineer Company

Inactivated 15 May 1959 at Rocky Mount, North Carolina

Activated 16 September 2008 at Asheville, North Carolina
