Constituted 25 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 631st Engineer Light Equipment Company

Activated 8 May 1943 at Camp Breckinridge, Kentucky

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 23 June 1947 as the 358th Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 27 June 1947 at Shamokin, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 11 August 1948 as the 358th Engineer Heavy Equipment Company

Reorganized and redesignated 23 November 1953 as the 358th Engineer Company

Inactivated 4 May 1959 at Shamokin, Pennsylvania

Activated 16 September 2008 at New Cumberland, Pennsylvania
