Redesignated 11 June 1947 as the 362d Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 16 July 1947 at Gainesville, Florida

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 3 November 1948 as the 362d Engineer Heavy Equipment Company

Inactivated 31 July 1953 at Gainesville, Florida

Redesignated 11 June 1954 as the 362d Engineer Company, withdrawn from the Army Reserve, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 August 1954 at Fort Knox, Kentucky

Activated 27 March 1963 at Fort Lee, Virginia

Inactivated 10 December 1970 in Vietnam
