Constituted 26 June 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 3336th Engineer Refrigeration Maintenance Detachment

Activated 26 July 1945 in France

Inactivated 12 November 1945 in France

Redesignated 5 February 1953 as the 36th Engineer Water Tank Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 April 1953 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 36th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 20 January 1955 in Korea

Activated 15 October 1957 in Japan

Inactivated 25 March 1959 in Korea

Activated 26 March 1963 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Activated 30 October 1970 at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana

Inactivated 15 August 1987 at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana


