Constituted 25 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 627th Engineer Light Equipment Company

Activated 1 April 1943 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 29 October 1945 at Camp Polk, Louisiana

Redesignated 5 June 1947 as the 370th Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 20 June 1947 at Houston, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps)

Reorganized and redesignated 17 December 1948 as the 370th Engineer Heavy Equipment Company

Inactivated 30 September 1949 at Houston, Texas

Withdrawn 11 September 1950 from the Organized Reserve Corps and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 October 1950 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Redesignated 20 October 1953 as the 370th Engineer Company

Inactivated 1 November 1975 in Germany

Activated 16 August 2007 in Germany
