Activated 26 April 1943 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Redesignated 16 July 1943 as the 705th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company

Inactivated 30 June 1946 at Livorno, Italy

Redesignated 26 May 1947 as the 374th Engineer Dump Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 11 June 1947 at Milwaukee, Wisconsin

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 17 November 1950 at Milwaukee, Wisconsin

Redesignated 2 April 2008 as the 374th Engineer Company

Activated 16 October 2010 at Vallejo, California

Location changed 10 June 2013 to Concord, California


