Constituted 8 June 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 799th Engineer Forestry Company

Activated 15 June 1942 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 12 December 1945 in the Philippines

Redesignated 12 May 1947 as the 375th Engineer Forestry Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 15 June 1947 at Vancouver, Washington

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 28 November 1949 at Vancouver, Washington

Redesignated 13 March 1956 as the 375th Engineer Company

Activated 26 March 1956 at Ellensburg, Washington

Location changed 10 June 1959 to Great Falls, Montana; on 1 October 1964 to Logan, Utah

Inactivated 29 February 1968 at Logan, Utah

Activated 16 September 1989 at Fort Ord, California

Inactivated 15 September 1997 at Fort Ord, California

Activated 16 September 2007 at Huntsville, Alabama

Ordered into active military service 14 April 2009 at Huntsville, Alabama; released from active military service 18 May 2010 and reverted to reserve status
