Inactivated 30 November 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 2 April 1947 as the 377th Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 18 April 1947 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 30 June 1950 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Redesignated 22 December 1955 as the 377th Engineer Company

Activated 23 January 1956 at Butler, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 28 February 1963 at Butler, Pennsylvania
