Constituted 8 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 625th Engineer Light Equipment Company

Activated 1 March 1943 at Camp White, Oregon

Inactivated 28 February 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 8 May 1947 as the 381st Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 30 May 1947 at Augusta, Georgia

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 1 August 1950 at Augusta, Georgia

Redesignated 13 April 1953 as the 381st Engineer Company

Activated 30 April 1953 at Fort Valley, Georgia

Location changed 15 June 1956 to Columbus, Georgia

Inactivated 15 May 1959 at Columbus, Georgia

Activated 16 September 2008 at Tifton, Georgia


