Redesignated 2 May 1947 as the 386th Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 16 May 1947 at Dallas, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 8 March 1950 at Dallas, Texas

Redesignated 24 September 2009 as the 386th Engineer Company

Activated 16 September 2012 at Las Vegas, Nevada

Location changed 15 November 2012 to Sloan, Nevada


