Organized 1 April 1980 in the Texas Army National Guard from existing units in the Houston area as the 386th Engineer Battalion with Headquarters at Houston

Location of Headquarters changed 1 September 1994 to Corpus Christi

Assigned 1 September 1996 to the 49th Armored Division

49th Armored Division reorganized and redesignated 1 May 2004 as the 36th Infantry Division

Ordered into active Federal service 26 June 2004 at Corpus Christi; released from active Federal service 4 January 2006 and reverted to state control

Reorganized 1 September 2007 to consist of Headquarters and Support Company

Location of Headquarters changed 1 August 2021 to Bastrop

Location of Headquarters changed 1 September 2023 to Corpus Christi
