395th ENGINEER DETACHMENT

Constituted 9 March 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 1034th Engineer Gas Generating Unit

Activated 15 March 1944 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Reorganized and redesignated 14 January 1945 as the 1034th Engineer Acetylene, Nitrogen, and Oxygen Gas Generator Team

Redesignated 10 April 1945 as the 1034th Engineer Gas Generating Detachment

Inactivated 6 November 1945 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Redesignated 27 October 1948 as the 395th Engineer Gas Generating Detachment and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 17 November 1948 at Portland, Oregon

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Portland, Oregon

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 20 October 1953 as the 395th Engineer Detachment

Released from active military service 1 February 1955 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 2 February 1955 at Portland, Oregon

Activated 14 January 1957 at Portland, Oregon
