Constituted 24 July 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 411th Engineer Base Shop Battalion

Activated 24 July -17 August 1942 at Camp Edwards, Massachusetts

Reorganized and redesignated 1 November 1944 as the 411th Engineer Special Shop Battalion

Inactivated 4 February 1946 at Camp Stoneman, California

Redesignated 26 October 1953 as the 411th Engineer Battalion and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 18 November 1953 at Fort DeRussy, Hawaii

Location changed 1 September 1994 to Fort Shafter, Hawaii

Ordered into active military service 5 January 2004 at Fort Shafter, Hawaii; released from active military service in 2005 and reverted to reserve status

(Lettered companies inactivated 16 September 2008 at home stations; Support Company concurrently constituted and activated)
