Activated 1 June 1947 at Birmingham, Alabama

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 1 May 1950 at Birmingham, Alabama

Redesignated 31 March 1955 as the 411th Engineer Company and activated at Mobile, Alabama

Inactivated 15 May 1959 at Mobile, Alabama
