Constituted 19 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 412th Engineer Dump Truck Company

Activated 25 January 1943 at Camp Swift, Texas

Inactivated 1 September 1947 in Germany

Redesignated 27 September 1948 as the 412th Engineer Panel Bridge Transport Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 4 October 1948 at Boston, Massachusetts

Inactivated 18 October 1949 at Boston, Massachusetts

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 5 November 1962 as the 412th Engineer Company

Activated 15 February 1963 at Lynn, Massachusetts

Location changed 16 June 1969 to Lawrence, Massachusetts; on 1 December 1974 to Danvers, Massachusetts; on 31 July 1976 to West Hazleton, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 15 February 1996 at West Hazleton, Pennsylvania

Activated 16 September 2008 at Scranton, Pennsylvania
