Constituted 5 January 1943 in the Regular Army as the 417th Engineer Dump Truck Company

Activated 15 February 1943 at Camp Sutton, North Carolina

Inactivated 1 June 1946 at Kitzingen, Germany

Redesignated 5 September 1950 as the 417th Engineer Panel Bridge Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 21 November 1950 at New York, New York

Location changed 20 April 1952 to Watertown, New York

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 17 January 1954 as the 417th Engineer Company

Inactivated 1 May 1959 at Watertown, New York

Activated 16 September 2008 at Bullville, New York

Ordered into active military service 28 January 2017 at Bullville, New York; released from active military service 3 March 2018 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 18 April 2024 at Bullville, New York
