Activated 25 January 1943 at Fort Snelling, Minnesota

Inactivated 31 May 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 7 March 1947 as the 441st Engineer Ponton Bridge Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 24 March 1947 at El Paso, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1950 as the 441st Engineer Treadway Bridge Company

Reorganized and redesignated 11 May 1953 as the 441st Engineer Float Bridge Company

Reorganized and redesignated 13 July 1953 as the 441st Engineer Company

Inactivated 27 March 1963 at El Paso, Texas

Activated 16 September 2008 at Millington, Tennessee


