Redesignated 3 February 1948 as the 450th Engineer Fire Fighting Platoon and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 11 February 1948 at Camden, New Jersey

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 7 August 1950 at Camden, New Jersey

Activated 5 January 1951 at Charleston, West Virginia

Inactivated 20 August 1951 at Charleston, West Virginia

Redesignated 24 September 2009 as the 450th Engineer Platoon

Activated 16 September 2012 at Camp Pendleton, California
