Inactivated 27 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 18 March 1947 as the 455th Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 28 April 1947 at Kansas City, Kansas

Location changed 29 January 1948 to Wichita, Kansas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 December 1948 at Wichita, Kansas

Redesignated 10 March 1949 as the 455th Engineer Maintenance Company

Activated 18 April 1949 at Los Angeles, California

Redesignated 1 December 1950 as the 455th Engineer Aviation Maintenance Company; concurrently location changed to Klamath Falls, Oregon

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1952 as the 455th Engineer Aviation Field Maintenance Company; concurrently location changed to Olympia, Washington

Reorganized and redesignated 20 May 1953 as the 455th Engineer Aviation Company

Redesignated 1 February 1957 as the 455th Engineer Company
