Constituted 12 November 1941 in the Army of the United States as the 469th Engineer Shop Company

Activated 1 December 1941 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Reorganized and redesignated 31 May 1942 as the 469th Engineer Maintenance Company

Inactivated 17 September 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Allotted 18 November 1946 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 26 November 1946 at Moline, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 15 November 1950 at Moline, Illinois

Redesignated 21 March 1952 as the 469th Engineer Dump Truck Company

Activated 15 April 1952 at Chicago, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 16 February 1953 as the 469th Engineer Company

Inactivated 8 November 1955 at Chicago, Illinois

Activated 23 August 1956 at Newton, Illinois

Inactivated 31 May 1959 at Newton, Illinois

Activated 16 September 2008 at Dodgeville, Wisconsin

Ordered into active military service 20 August 2010 at Dodgeville, Wisconsin; released from active military service 23 September 2011 and reverted to reserve status
