Activated 13 September 1945 in China

Inactivated 15 December 1945 in China

Allotted 13 August 1946 to the Regular Army

Activated 28 December 1946 on Okinawa as the 3352d Engineer Utilities Detachment (Philippine Scouts)

Inactivated 30 April 1947 on Okinawa; concurrently withdrawn from the Philippine Scouts

Redesignated 5 February 1953 as the 46th Engineer Utilities Detachment

Activated 10 April 1953 in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 46th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 25 June 1958 in Korea

Activated 25 June 1959 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky

Inactivated 15 July 1982 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona

Activated 16 April 2010 at Fort Carson, Colorado
