Constituted 8 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 486th Engineer Heavy Shop Company

Activated 20 December 1942 at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana

Inactivated 8 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Allotted 16 January 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 31 January 1947 at Flint, Michigan

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; on 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 4 December 1950 at Flint, Michigan

Redesignated 16 April 1959 as the 486th Engineer Company

Activated 1 May 1959 at Dearborn, Michigan

Location changed 31 January 1963 to Muskegon, Michigan

Inactivated 31 December 1990 at Muskegon, Michigan

Activated 16 September 2008 at Monclova, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 20 August 2019 at Monclova, Ohio; released from active military service 21 November 2020 and reverted to reserve status
