Inactivated 20 January 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 18 December 1946 as the 492d Engineer Light Equipment Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 6 January 1947 at Peoria, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 December 1948 at Peoria, Illinois

Redesignated 23 February 1949 as the 492d Engineer Parts Supply Company

Activated 24 March 1949 at Minneapolis, Minnesota

Inactivated 22 January 1951 at Minneapolis, Minnesota

Redesignated 3 December 1963 as the 492d Engineer Company

Activated 1 April 1964 at Mankato, Minnesota

Inactivated 15 July 1994 at Mankato, Minnesota

Activated 16 September 2007 at Mankato, Minnesota


