Redesignated 6 January 1945 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1054th Engineer Port Construction and Repair

Inactivated 20 December 1945 in Japan

Redesignated 12 May 1949 as the 50th Engineer Port Construction Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 20 June 1949 at Fort Worden, Washington

Redesignated 27 March 1954 as the 50th Engineer Company

Inactivated 25 March 1959 in Korea

Activated 7 December 1959 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 15 September 1972 at West Point, New York
