Constituted 21 June 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 2005th Engineer Aviation Fire Fighting Platoon

Activated 1 July 1943 at Bradley Field, Connecticut

Inactivated 20 November 1945 in France

Redesignated 12 March 1951 as the 520th Engineer Fire Fighting Platoon and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 April 1951 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 20 October 1953 in France

Redesignated 30 September 1966 as the 520th Engineer Platoon

Activated 1 December 1966 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland

Redesignated 5 October 1971 as the 520th Engineer Detachment


