Activated 20 April 1944 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Reorganized and redesignated 16 November 1945 as the 526th Engineer Panel Bridge Transport Company

Reorganized and redesignated 27 May 1949 as the 526th Engineer Panel Bridge Company; concurrently allotted to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 526th Engineer Company

Inactivated 31 March 1971 in Korea

Activated 16 October 2008 at Fort Stewart, Georgia


