**527th ENGINEER BATTALION**

Constituted 15 August 1973 in the Louisiana Army National Guard as the 527th Engineer Battalion and organized from new and existing units with Headquarters at Bossier City

Ordered into active Federal service 6 December 1990 at home stations; released 25 May 1991 from active Federal service and reverted to state control

Location of Headquarters changed 1 July 1991 to Ruston

Ordered into active Federal service 3 January 2003 at home stations; released from active Federal service 2 January 2004 and reverted to state control

Reorganized 1 September 2006 to consist of Headquarters and Headquarters Company and the Support Company (concurrently; Company A reorganized and redesignated as the 844th Engineer Company, Companies B and C as the 1022d Engineer Company - hereafter separate lineages)

Ordered into active Federal service 25 February 2021 at home stations; released from active Federal service 24 February 2022 and reverted to state control
