Constituted 15 June 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 2949th Engineer Technical Intelligence Team

Activated 26 June 1944 at Camp Campbell, Kentucky

Redesignated 30 April 1947 as the 533d Engineer Technical Intelligence Team

Reorganized and redesignated 14 September 1953 as the 533d Engineer Detachment; concurrently allotted to the Regular Army

Inactivated 18 December 1967 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Activated 1 May 1968 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 16 November 1971 in Vietnam

Activated 21 June 1974 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Inactivated in 1982 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Activated 16 October 2007 at Darien, Illinois


