Redesignated 12 March 1951 as the 518th Engineer Fire Fighting Platoon and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 April 1951 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 20 October 1953 as the 537th Engineer Detachment

Inactivated 20 September 1958 in Germany

Activated 25 June 1965 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri

Inactivated 14 December 1970 in Vietnam

Activated 1 September 1980 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 15 August 1988 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Activated 16 October 2005 at Fort Lewis, Washington
