Constituted 18 May 1917 in the National Army as Company E, 25th Engineers

Organized 13 September 1917 at Camp Devens, Massachusetts

Demobilized 20 May 1919 at Camp Upton, New York

Reconstituted 18 October 1927 in the Regular Army as Company E, 25th Engineers

Redesignated 8 January 1942 as Company E, 25th Armored Engineer Battalion, an element of the 6th Armored Division

Activated 15 February 1942 at Fort Knox, Kentucky

Reorganized and redesignated 16 November 1943 as the 990th Engineer Treadway Bridge Company, and relieved from assignment to the 6th Armored Division

Inactivated 9 December 1945 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Redesignated 30 January 1947 as the 541st Engineer Treadway Bridge Company

Redesignated 17 December 1951 as the 541st Engineer Panel Bridge Company

Activated 16 January 1952 at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin

Inactivated 15 August 1952 at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin

Redesignated 23 November 1954 as the 541st Engineer Company

Inactivated 16 January 1986 in Germany
