Inactivated 25 March 1954 at Fort Dix, New Jersey

Redesignated 17 May 1966 as the 544th Engineer Company

Activated 1 July 1966 at Fort Irwin, California

Inactivated 20 March 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 October 2010 at Fort Carson, Colorado
