Reorganized and redesignated 22 May 1944 as the 3338th Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 25 October 1945 at Camp Shanks, New York

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3338th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 5 October 1948 as the 218th Transportation Amphibious Truck Company and concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 19 October 1948 at Columbus, Georgia

Inactivated 1 September 1950 at Columbus, Georgia

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 30 September 1958 as the 218th Transportation Company

Activated 15 October 1958 at Columbus, Georgia

Inactivated 15 January 1963 at Columbus, Georgia
