Inactivated 30 September 1945 in Germany

Redesignated 13 November 1950 as the 550th Engineer Map Depot Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 November 1950 in Korea

Inactivated 15 April 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 8 June 1961 as the 550th Engineer Detachment

Activated 1 July 1961 at Fort Hood, Texas

Inactivated 1 January 1966 in Korea

Inactivated 23 August 1968 in Vietnam
